Groceries

20 lbs Chicken-10lbs white boneless breast, 10lbs boneless thighs - should order 21 lbs next year

10 large onions

7 bunches celery

5lbs carrots

5 pkg Wild Rice (is plenty cooked up) makes 10 times our original recipe

2lbs Decaf Coffee

6 boxes crackers

10 loaves french bread = sliced

10lbs flour

20 – 8oz pkg sliced mushrooms

5lbs Butter - 4lbs would be enough

10 quarts – Half & Half

2-12oz containers Chicken Base

1-7.5oz cantainer Natures Seasoning

1-small container White Pepper

Cream & Sugar packets – 50 each

Gloves

Bowls – 250

Plates – 280

Cups – 270 Hot Cups - 225

Spoons – 250

25 lbs Hamberger was donated by Ken & Jancie Durst - great plenty for 8 gals of soup (20lbs-would be enough) & 4lbs butter used at the tables.

(Kasson Legion – made the vegetable soup) – very good - (had 2-ice cream buckets left over)

Kwik Trip – donated – 3 gal white milk & 4 gal choc milk

34 pies were brought in and we may have had 3-whole pies left over

We made 10 batches of Chicken Wild Rice – and had 1 ½ batches left over (3-ice cream bucket left over)

We donated the left over soup to TAC – Christian School – Johan Marsland – paster
