

Faith in Action Soup & Pie Event October 14th, 2019

We had a very successful Soup & Pie event this year with an estimated total ticket sale of 236 and a gross deposit of around \$3200.00. "Thank You" to all the volunteers for helping out with making pies and those who worked the event to make it run so smoothly. This is all so very much appreciated.

We had about 20 gallons of Chicken Wild Rice soup – which we ran out of at around 6 – 6:15pm (16 gallons donated to us by Knights of Columbus)-Thank You so very generous
And 12 gallons of Vegetable Beef soup – which we had about 2 – quarts left over at the end of the night.
(Paige Morris from the Kasson Legion came to help make around 2:30pm)

The following list of groceries were purchased for the event:

- 12 loaves of French Bread sliced – 1 gallon bag left over
- 6 Boxes of Crackers – 1 gallon bag left over
- 5 lbs of Butter - 1 lb left over
- 4 large tubs of Cool Whip – gone
- 2 large cans of Coffee – Regular & Decaf – made 2-Decaf pots, 1-55 cup Regular and had to make 5 more Regular Bun coffee pots to keep up with demand
- 1 large bag of Ice
- 7 bags of Milk from Kwik Trip – 4-Chocolate, 3-White, but ran to get 4 more gallons at Erdman's-1 gallon left over at the end of the night.
- 12 lbs of Ground Beef
- 5 Stalks of Celery
- 7 lbs of Carrots
- 7 large Onions
- 5 large Rutabagas
- 7 28oz Diced Canned Tomatoes
- 7 bags of frozen Mixed Vegetables-peas & carrots
- 3 large containers of Beef Boullion
- 1 jar of Garlic Powder
- 1 small can of Pepper
- 1 Salt

38 Pies brought in from volunteers that Mary Lou McClamrock called, plus we had to buy 3-more from Erdman's

Total cost of groceries was **\$333.65** and we have a credit balance remaining at Erdman's of **-\$320.76**.

Trinity Lutheran Church youth group came to help serve and keep tables cleaned. (about 12 total) along with Adam Anderson youth leader .
